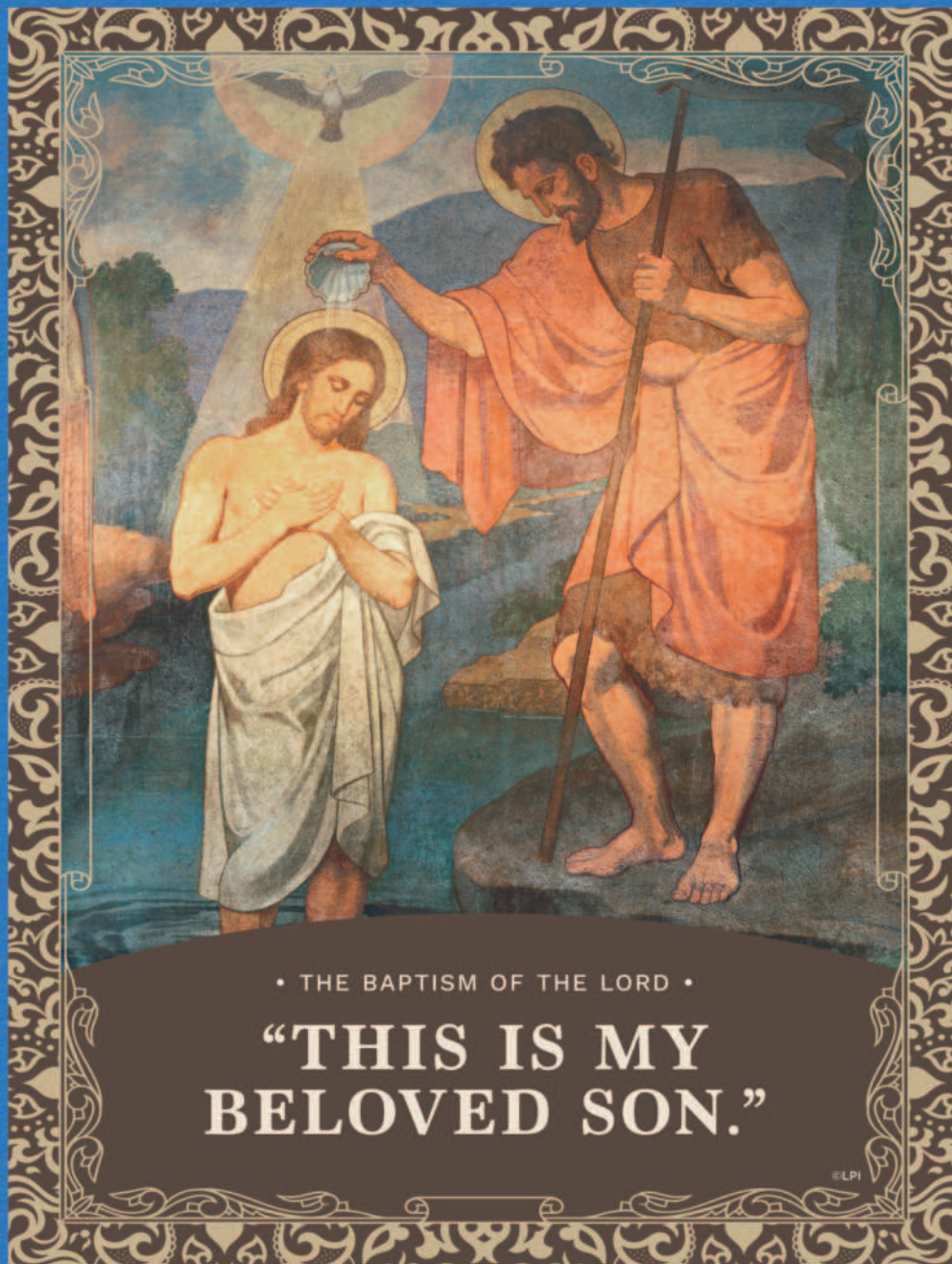

# Pastor's Notes



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today, on the banks of the Jordan, we hear of the dramatic scene of Our Lord's baptism. This event is the first time that Our Lord enters the public scene as an adult, after leaving Nazareth. Upon reaching the Jordan River, Our Lord is among the crowd that is listening to John the Baptist. He lines up like everyone else, waiting to be baptized by John. John the Baptist sees Our Lord approaching and he recognizes that Jesus is the One for whom he has been waiting for his whole life. John understands Jesus is the One who is greater than he and that he was not even worthy to untie His sandals.

In this most dramatic event, Our Lord emerges from the water after His Baptism and the skies open. As we hear from St. Luke's Gospel: "The heaven was opened, and the Holy Spirit descended upon him" (3:21-22); and words were heard that had never been heard before: "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased" (v. 22). Jesus is the Son of God and has no need to be baptized but He is showing His extraordinary humility. Jesus takes upon His shoulders the burden of our sin and all sin. At the Baptism of Our Lord, He begins His mission by putting Himself in our place, in the place of sinners.

Through Baptism, you are united to Christ, becoming a member of His Body, the Church, and sharing in Her mission to the world. Baptism incorporates us into Christ and forms us into God's people. This first sacrament pardons all our sins, rescues us from the power of darkness, and brings us to the dignity of adopted children, a new creation through water and the Holy Spirit. Hence we are called and are indeed the children of God.

The Catholic Church teaches that Baptism is essential for salvation, either by actual reception or at least by desire. As the Code of Canon Law states: Baptism, the gateway to the sacraments and necessary for salvation by actual reception or at least by desire, is validly conferred only by a washing of true water with the proper form of words. This echoes the words of Christ: "Unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God" (Jn 3:5). Without Baptism, entry into eternal life is not possible, making it the first step in responding to God's call.

Having your child baptized is what Catholic parents do for their child. Nurturing and raising your baptized child in the faith is also vital to the spiritual life of the child. The rite of baptism makes this important connection during the celebration of the sacrament when the parents of those being baptized are reminded that they assume the commitment to "training them in the practice of the faith". The parents and godparents are also reminded in part of the celebration with the words addressed to them: "on your part, you must make it your constant care to bring them up in the practice of the faith. See that the divine life which God gives them is kept safe from the poison of sin, to grow always stronger in their hearts. If your faith makes you ready to accept this responsibility... profess your faith in Christ Jesus. This is the faith of the Church. This is the faith in which these children are about to be baptized".

Just before the water is poured on the head of the newborn child there is a further appeal to faith and then the Celebrant asks a final question: "Is it your will that your child should be baptized in the faith of the Church which we have all professed with you?" After the parents and godparents respond positively to that question, the sacrament of baptism takes place.

After the baptism, the Celebrant will hand them a candle that has been lit from the Paschal Candle. He says: "These children of yours have been enlightened by Christ. They are to walk always as children of the light. May they keep the flame of faith alive in their hearts. When the Lord comes, may they go out to meet Him...". Parents "keep the flame of faith alive" by living as authentic Catholic parents and by modeling what it means to be a disciple of Jesus Christ. Of course, the Church is there to assist. Catholic schools and religious education can help form children in the faith, but schools and classes do not replace the vital role that parents have in their children's lives in handing on the Catholic faith.

With the anointing of the crown of the child's head with Sacred Chrism, the child is reminded that as "Christ was anointed Priest, Prophet, and King, so may you [the child] live always as a member of his body, sharing everlasting life." Then there is the clothing with the white garment and the lighting of the candle with the words: "These children of yours have been enlightened by Christ. They are to walk always as children of the light. May they keep the flame of faith alive in their hearts. When the Lord comes, may they go out to meet him...". Lastly, the Celebrant invites the Lord Jesus in the rite of the Ephphetha to "touch your ears to receive his word, and your mouth to proclaim his faith, to the praise and glory of God the Father". Then all this is crowned by the final Blessing that further reminds the parents of their responsibility to be for their children "the first witnesses to the faith".

With Baptism, the children become sharers in Christ's death and Resurrection. They begin with Him the joyful and amazing adventure of being disciples of Our Lord Jesus. This is our faith. This is the faith of the Church. We are proud to profess it, in Christ Jesus Our Lord.

May the celebration of the Baptism the Lord encourage each one of us to live the beauty and joy of being baptized disciples of Our Lord Jesus. May all faithful followers of Our Lord continue to bring our baptized children into the fullness of our faith to Christ. May we all seek to be faithful disciples of Christ and courageous witnesses of the Gospel forever and ever. Amen.

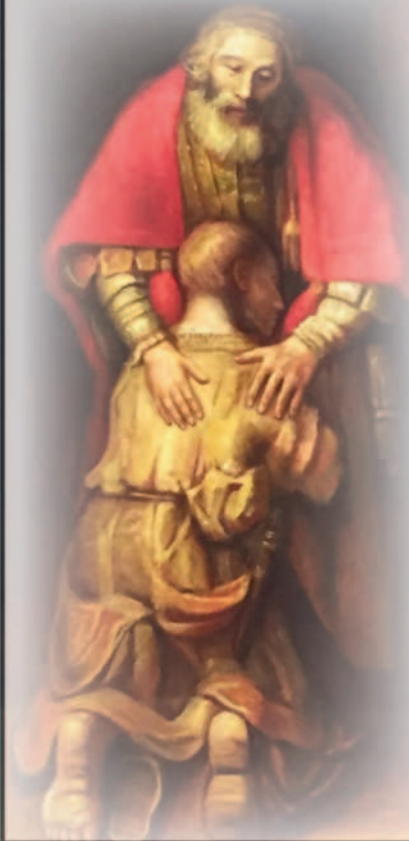




# EXPLORE A RETURN
