

# Pastor's Notes

## *Presentation of the Lord and Candlemas Day*

Dear Brothers and Sisters,



The Church celebrates Candlemas Day on February 2nd every year which is the celebration of the Presentation of the Lord. This feast celebrates three important events. It commemorates the day that Our Blessed Mother Mary came to the Temple as the Law required of all women, to go through a purification ceremony 40 days after giving birth. Because of this, it is also referred to as the Feast of the Purification of Mary and is the reason why it is always celebrated on February 2nd.

Today, we also remember when Mary and Joseph presented their newborn son, Jesus, to God in the Temple and offered a sacrifice on His behalf for His birth. All parents were required to do this for their firstborn sons. For this reason, it is referred to as the Feast of the Presentation of Jesus. Most importantly, however, bringing the infant Jesus to the Temple was a great event for the Jewish people.

Before the destruction of the First Temple and the Babylonian Captivity in 586 BC, the Prophet Ezekiel had a vision of God physically leaving the Temple. Then four hundred years before the birth of Jesus, the Prophet Malachi prophesied that God Himself would one day physically return to the Temple. He would appear suddenly and when it was least expected: "In time, the Lord whom you seek will come suddenly to His Temple" (Malachi 3:1).

When Mary and Joseph brought the infant Jesus to the Temple to present Him to God, this prophecy was fulfilled. It was important that this momentous event be noticed, and it was. There was a very elderly man named Simeon who spent all his time praying in the Temple. God had told him that he would see the Messiah before he died. While Mary and Joseph were fulfilling what the Law required, the Holy Spirit told Simeon that God, the Messiah, had physically returned to the Temple in the form of the infant Jesus.

The old man found Mary and Joseph, took the child in his arms, looked up to heaven and said: "Now, Master, you may let your servant go in peace, according to your word, for my eyes have seen your salvation, which you prepared in sight of all the peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel" (Luke 2:29-32). God had returned to His Temple as was prophesied. Jesus, the Messiah, would be the Savior not only of the People of Israel, but of all mankind! Most importantly, Jesus is the light who has come into the world to dispel the darkness of sin!

Because Candlemas Day celebrates these three important occasions, the purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the presentation of the Child Jesus, and Jesus' first entry into the Temple, this feast has long been celebrated with great solemnity. In some countries, Candlemas Day is the official end of the Christmas Season, and Christmas decorations are taken down and packed away. More importantly, however, since the Prophet Simeon said that Jesus is a light of revelation to the Gentiles, during this dark time of the year, the early Christians chose this time to celebrate Jesus as the Light of the world. For this reason, the priest blesses the candles that will be used during Mass, and people are encouraged to bring candles that they will use in their homes to be blessed as well. The Mass offered that day may include a beautiful candlelit celebration of light, and that is where the name "Candlemas" comes from.

On another note, in the 6th Century, a deadly plague broke out in the city of Constantinople. The emperor ordered the people to form a candlelit procession through the streets of the city to pray for deliverance from the plague on Candlemas Day. When the plague passed, candlelit processions became regular forms of prayer in Europe whenever a plague threatened the people. May Jesus the Light of the world dispel the darkness and bring us His peace. Happy Candlemas Day!

It is a travelling sacramental offered by the Legion of Mary for installation in your home to create an opportunity for families to embrace and deepen their faith thru prayer, reflection, and devotion to Mary.


**WHY:** The Pilgrim Virgin Mary Home Visitation is an aid to help us respond to the requests made by the Blessed Mother during her apparitions at Fatima. The essence of her requests is threefold:



- Return to God - turn away from sin and obey the Ten Commandments.
- Pray the Rosary - offer prayers daily for peace in our hearts, homes, and the world.
- Make Reparation for Sins – undertake acts of penance and sacrifice.

**HOW:** To schedule the visitation, contact Catherine Smith, President of the Legion of Mary - Our Lady of Lourdes Praesidium at (403) 580-9605, and the statue will be brought to your residence and installed with a beautiful prayer ceremony by members of the Legion of Mary with you. The statue may remain in your home for at least two weeks. At the end of the visitation, the members of the Legion of Mary will return to pray and recite "Mary's Farewell" with you. Then our Blessed Mother is once again ready to travel to another home of one of her children.




## Fasting, Explained

The practice of fasting predates Christianity. The Old Testament is full of examples of righteous men and women mortifying their flesh for the purpose of making atonement or simply to grow closer to God. Jesus himself fasted for forty days and forty nights in preparation for the beginning of His public ministry, and we see his disciples following His example in the Acts of the Apostles.

Fasting continues to be an important part of Christian devotional life today. Many people feel the practice of fasting enhances their prayer and helps them fulfill St. Paul's advice to "put to death the deeds of the body" (Romans 8:13) to grow in the Spirit. Most Catholics will associate fasting with the liturgical season of Lent, which is obligatory for members of the Catholic Church between ages 18 and 59.


