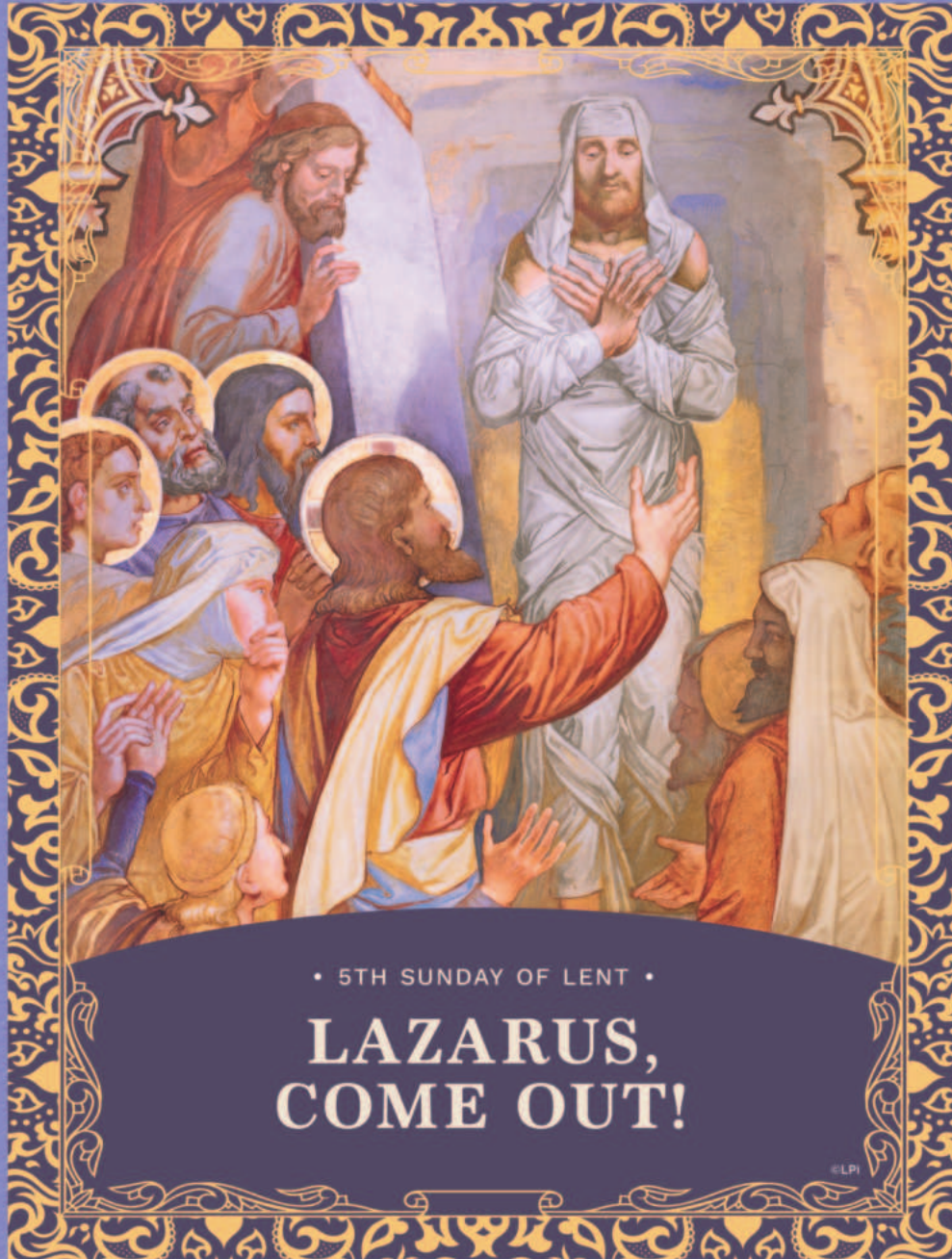

Pastor's Notes

Fifth Week of Lent



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I can hardly believe that we have arrived to the Fifth Sunday of Lent. Next Sunday will be Palm Sunday and the beginning of Holy Week. These past several weeks are meant to be a time of preparation for Easter and the Resurrection of Christ who conquered even death. Throughout Lent, Our Lord calls us to offer sacrifices, prayers, and penances. These 40 days are meant to be a special time to reconnect us with God and to clear out the clutter that has accumulated through our sinful decisions. It is never too late to reconnect with Our Lord's mercy and love. Prayerfully consider making a good confession. A good confession can bring peace to the soul and strength to deal with future temptations.

On another note, each year on the Fifth Sunday of Lent, the statues, crucifixes, and crosses in the Church are covered with purple veils until the end of Good Friday. Good Friday is when the Lord's Passion is celebrated and the priest or deacon solemnly unveils only the cross of Jesus for all to venerate. All present will be given a chance to venerate a relic of the true cross. Although the cross is revealed on Good Friday, the images remain veiled until the beginning of the Easter Vigil.

Why do we cover all the statues and crucifixes? These are days of mourning. The time of the Passion is consecrated to the memory of Christ's sufferings through which we have obtained redemption. This ancient custom of covering religious images is intended to help us focus on the penitential aspect of this liturgical season. It reminds us visually that our faith in all its glory is only possible through Christ's work in His suffering and death on the cross.

Finally, I invite you to offer the Stations of the Cross for the remaining Friday's in Lent at 7:00pm in the church. We will also have Stations of the Cross in the church at 7:00pm on Good Friday. Consider praying the Holy Rosary next Friday, March 27th, the last Friday of Lent, traditionally called the Friday of Sorrows, for all mothers suffering the loss of their child(ren). This day is also dedicated to meditating on the sufferings of our Mother Mary. Mary begins Her painful journey with Her Son, Jesus, on Good Friday.

Thank you for your active participation and dedication to our church family. May you have a fulfilling week as we approach the holiest week of the year. I invite you to please mark the Holy Week schedules on your calendars. You will find a detailed schedule of our Holy Week activities in the bulletin, but it doesn't hurt to remind yourself how important it is to participate in all the activities we will have at our parish.

THE SACRED TRIDUUM



The Sacred Triduum is the heart of the Catholic liturgical year. Flowing from the evening of Holy Thursday until Easter Sunday, which begins with the Easter Vigil, it commemorates the saving mysteries of Christ's Passion, Death, and Resurrection. The term "Triduum" means "three days," yet it is celebrated as one unified mystery of redemption.

The Catechism teaches us that "Jesus' hour has come" (CCC 1165), and in the liturgy the Church makes present this saving hour. The Triduum begins with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, recalling Christ's institution of the Eucharist and the priesthood at the Last Supper. As the Catechism states, "Our Savior instituted the Eucharistic sacrifice of his Body and Blood... in order to perpetuate the sacrifice of the cross throughout the ages" (CCC 1323). The washing of the feet at this Mass reflects Christ's commandment of charity and humble service (cf. CCC 1823).

On Good Friday, the Church solemnly commemorates the Passion and death of the Lord. "Jesus atoned for our faults and made satisfaction for our sins to the Father" (CCC 615). His death is the definitive sacrifice, fulfilling and surpassing all others (CCC 614). The faithful venerate the Cross, recognizing it as the instrument of salvation.

Holy Saturday is marked by silence and waiting at the Lord's tomb. The Catechism explains that Christ "descended into hell" to free the righteous who had died before him (CCC 633). This expresses the fullness of Christ's victory over death.

The Triduum culminates in the Easter Vigil, "the mother of all holy vigils" (CCC 1169), celebrating the Resurrection, the foundation of Christian faith (CCC 638). In the risen Christ, the faithful are given new life, and the Paschal Mystery becomes the source of all grace and hope.

ANIMA CHRISTI



The Anima Christi prayer takes its name from its opening lines: Soul of Christ, “Anima Christi” in Latin. In this prayer, the faithful invoke the image of Christ crucified, calling upon the salvific elements of his wounds, his Body and his Blood to strengthen them, imploring him to save them from “the malicious enemy” and to bring them, in their final hour, to his presence.

The author of this prayer is unknown, but it originated in the 14th century and was referenced in St. Ignatius’ Spiritual Exercises. It is traditionally said after or before receiving the Eucharist.

Soul of Christ, sanctify me.
Body of Christ, save me.
Blood of Christ, inebriate me.
Water from the side of Christ, wash me.
Passion of Christ, strengthen me.
O Good Jesus, hear me.
Within your wounds hide me.
Permit me not to be separated from you.
From the wicked foe, defend me.
At the hour of my death, call me
and bid me come to you
That with your saints I may praise you
For ever and ever. Amen.

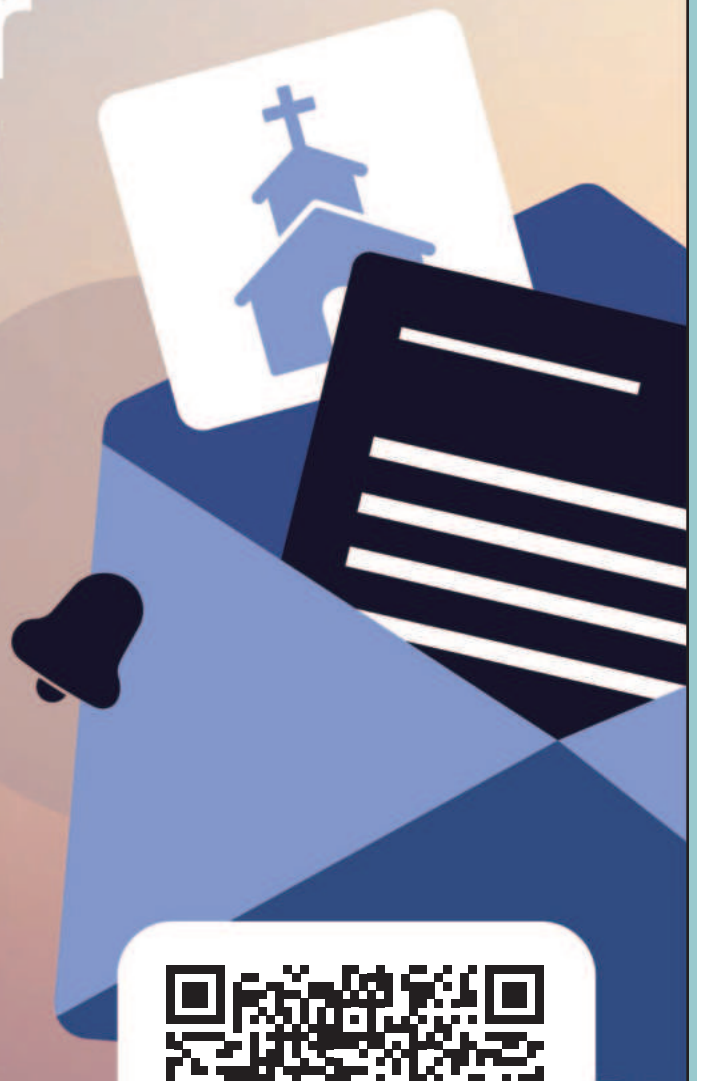

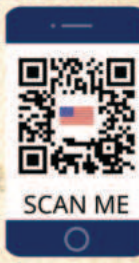
