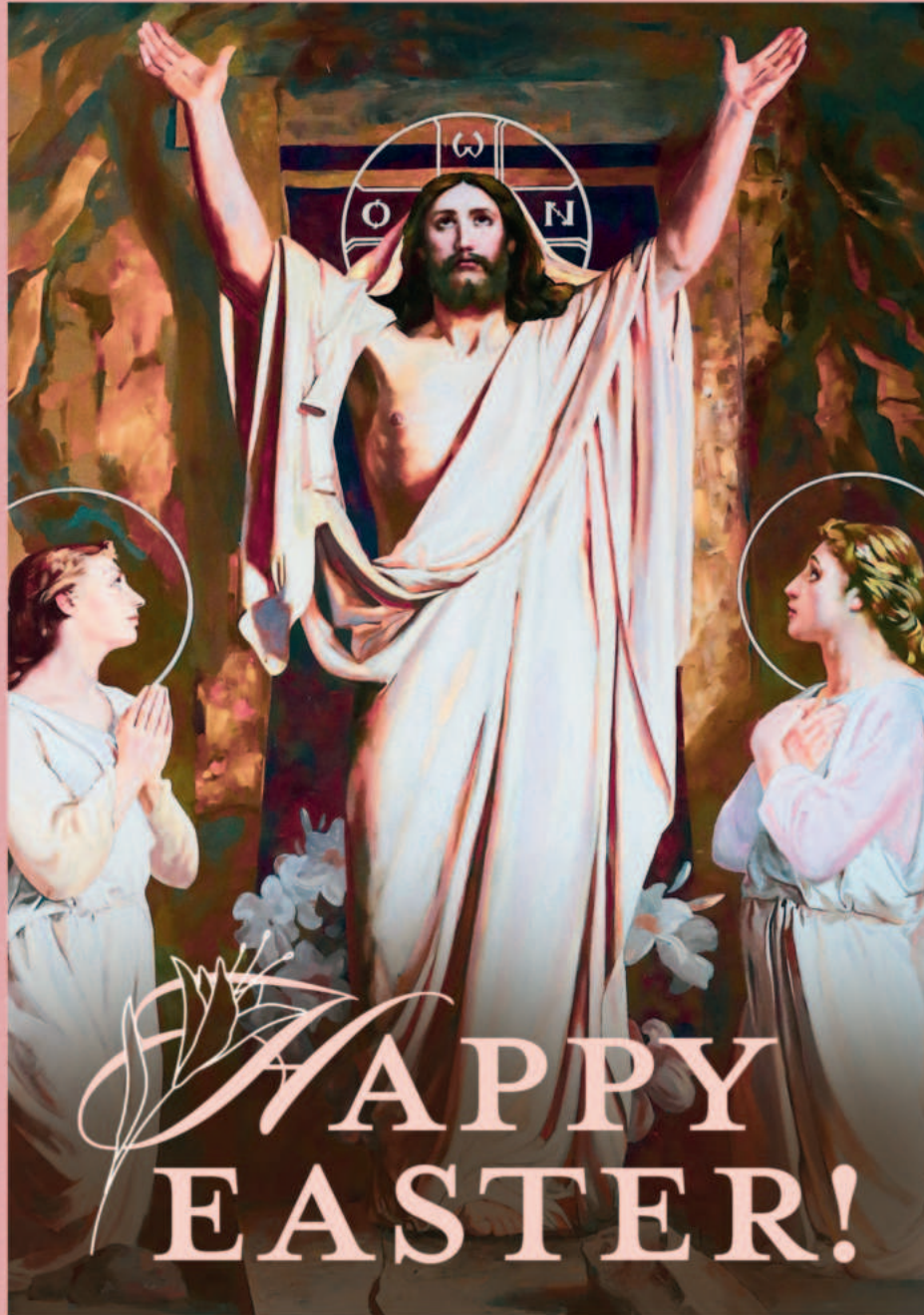

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

**Blessed Easter Sunday! Alleluia! Resurrexit Sicut Dixit: He Is Risen as He Said!** Every Sunday we celebrate the reality that Jesus, Our Lord, has risen from the dead, but on Easter Sunday the Church sends a proclamation of the Risen Lord that resounds throughout the world. Beginning with the Easter Vigil, and the lighting of the Paschal Candle from the Easter fire, Christ the Light of the world shines brightly for all to see. On this night, the family of God grows as we welcome our newest Catholics into the Church. Despite the presence of violence, war, division, and death, the resurrection of the Messiah, Our Savior, brings hope and joy to the world and scatters the darkness.

The Church has joyfully proclaimed that Christ is the Lord of life. Jesus has conquered death and truly is the resurrection and the life of the world. Christ has died! Christ is risen! Christ will come again! For 2,000 years, the Church has been celebrating the Paschal Mystery – Christ's journey from death to life and our journey from sin to grace, from fear to trust, from isolation to communion.

Every Easter we celebrate the fact that Christ's love cannot be contained. Love must be shared. This Easter joy is to be reflected in one's commitment to faith. Our daily prayer can strengthen our love for the Risen Lord. The Church and the Sacraments are meant to help you fall deeper in love with Our Lord, our parish family and all those you meet. Every Easter, we renew the promises made at our baptism. As we reflect on our baptismal promises, we restate and affirm our belief in God and what it means to live our Catholic faith in concrete ways.

As you embrace the faith and fall deeper in love with Our Lord, it is natural to want to foster active participation in parish ministries. Living one's faith includes serving others. You see this living faith expressed in spouses who seek to live sacrificial love. You see living faith expressed in parents who love their children enough to teach them the faith. In the life of the parish, you see our faith lived in real ways as lectors, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to the homebound, and ushers, just to name a few. All these ways and more are signs of sharing Easter joy. We must rise with Our Lord by living our faith in meaningful ways. Let your selfish ways die and be raised to new life in Christ!

I give thanks to God for all our volunteers: ushers, lectors, sacristans, Knights of the Altar, musicians, cantors, those who make meals for families in need, as well as the Knights of Columbus, who, in communion with members of our staff, make such willing sacrifices to ensure that Sacred Liturgies are always reverent, beautiful, and organized with great dignity. 


## THE EASTER SEASON




In the Catholic Church, Easter is not celebrated as a single day but as a 50-day season that begins on Easter Sunday and ends on Pentecost. This extended celebration honors the Resurrection of Our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. This is the central mystery of the Christian faith; Jesus rose from the dead, conquering sin and death. The 50 days symbolize fullness and joy in the biblical tradition and reflect the time the risen Christ appeared to His disciples before sending the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. Because the Resurrection is the foundation of Christian hope, the Church celebrates it not for a single day but as a season of continued rejoicing and renewal.

The first eight days after Easter form the Octave of Easter, when each day is celebrated with the same joy as Easter Sunday. During this time, families and individuals can continue celebrating by attending Mass, praying together, reading the Gospel accounts of the Resurrection, and sharing meals with gratitude for God's blessings. Homes may keep Easter symbols such as flowers, candles, or crosses as reminders of new life. Families can also perform acts of kindness or charity, reflecting the love and hope that the Resurrection brings to the world. It is common to greet fellow Christians with the phrase "He is Risen!" with the response of "He is Risen, indeed!" during the Easter octave.



Throughout the entire Easter season leading up to Pentecost, the faithful can deepen their faith through attending Mass, continued prayer, Scripture reading, and acts of service. By living with joy, gratitude, and mercy, Catholics continue celebrating the hope and new life that the Resurrection brings.

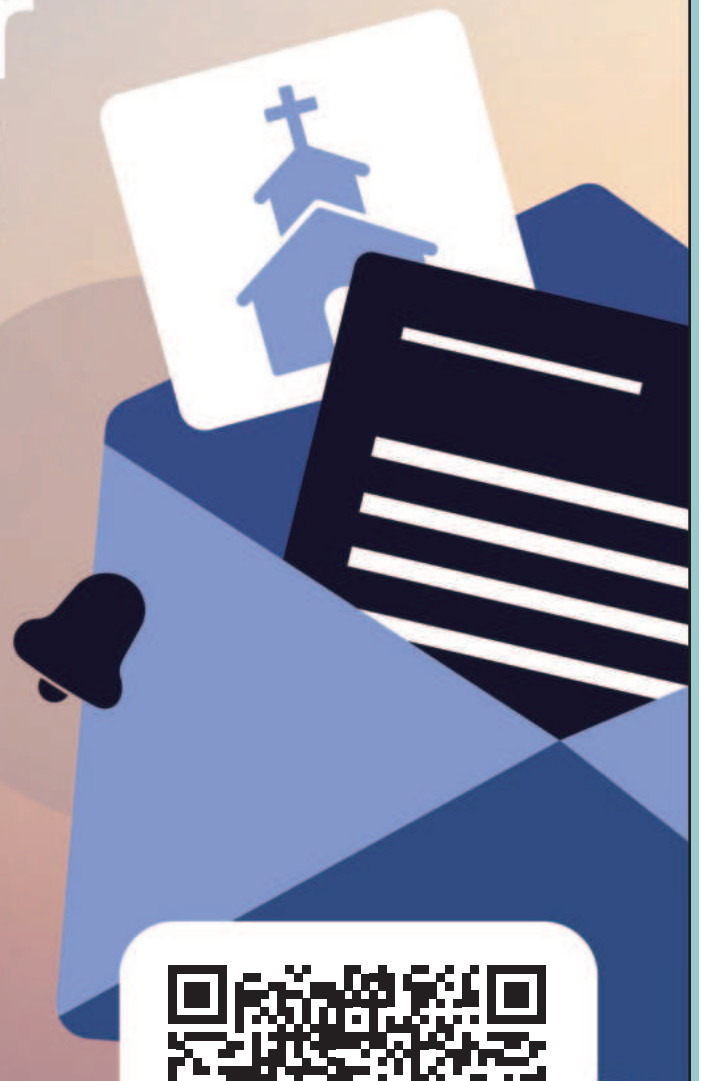
